I., on the following described tract of real estate situated in the town of Skiatook Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory to-wit: Lot number six (6), seven (7) and eight (8) in Block Number ten, as per plat and survey of J. Gus Patton, according to the official plat and survey thereof.
