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Bradley Realty Bank and Trust Co.,

to

The Texas Company.

Right of Way Grant.

United States of America, Indian Territory, Western District, } Know all men by these presents: that the undersigned Bradley
Realty Bank and Trust Co. (hereinafter styled "Grantor") in consideration of twenty six (\$26) dollars in hand paid by the Texas
Company, a corporation of Texas, both hereby grant and convey unto the said The Texas Company (herein styled "Grantee")
its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain a pipeline for the transportation of oil
or gas over, through and upon a certain tract of land situated in the Western Judicial District and the 26th Recording
District of the Indian Territory, and described as follows: The east one half of the South West quarter and the South West
quarter of the South West quarter of section thirty five (35) in Township nineteen (19) North, Range twelve (12) East

There is also hereby granted the right to erect and maintain upon and across said premises, a line of pole and telegraph
and telephone wires thereon, and also the right to lay adjacent to and parallel with the first pipe line a second pipe
line, and the Grantee, its successors and assigns, shall at all reasonable times have the right of ingress and egress
to and from said line or lines for the purposes of construction, inspecting, repairing and maintaining the same and the
removal of such at will in whole or in part.

The Grantee, its successors and assigns, to select the route of such lines:

To Have and to Hold the said covenants unto the said The Texas Company, its successors and assigns, so
long as such structures are maintained.

By acceptance hereof the Grantee covenants for itself, successors and assigns, that it will so bury
said pipe lines as that such will not interfere with the cultivation of the premises, and also that it will
pay all damages to crops and fences which may be suffered from the laying, maintaining and operating
said pipe line.

It is understood that the person securing this right of way in behalf of the Grantee is without authority
to make any covenant or agreement in respect to the premises not expressed herein.
