Wharton have this day advanced for Will Ward of Tulsa, Indian Territory, the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) to be paid attorneys in obtaining the enrollment of the said Will Ward as a citizen of the Cherokee Nation; Now therefore this agreement, made and entered into this 7 day of February, A.D. 1902, by and between Will Ward, of Tulsa, Indian Territory, party of the first part, and N. A. McKee and Mr. W. Wharton, both of Tulsa, Indian Territory, parties of the second part.

Witnesseth: That in consideration of the parties of the second part having this day advanced the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) to attorneys for the party of the first part, the said party of the first part agrees to give to the parties of the second part a mortgage on whatever lands he hereafter acquires in the Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, as security for money which they have this day advanced and which may be advanced under this contract.
