Power of Attorney

Buchfinger of Tulsa, Indian Territory, my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name and stead, to lease, demise and let and to contract to let, demise and lease for the production of oil, gas and water, the following described property, being the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 33, Township 21, Range 13 East. This power of attorney being given for a period of two years from date. Also the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 21, Range 13 East, belonging to Alongo Ward, and the S 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 21, Range 13 East, owned and possessed by Savannah Ward my daughter, a minor. It is understood that the power of attorney is to remain in full force and effect for a period of two years from this date, giving and granting unto my said attorney full power and authority to do and perform every act and thing whatsoever necessary and requisite to be done in the premises, as I might or could do if personally present. Hereby making said power and authority irrevocable until the purposes for which same is created shall have been fully performed, according to the power herein granted.
