Power of Attorney

Know all men by these Presents, that I, the undersigned of Tulsa, Ind. Terr., being of lawful age and a freedman of the Cherokee Nation, do hereby make, constitute, and appoint, H. H. Rockfingus of Tulsa, Indian Territory my true and lawful attorney, for me and in my name and stead to let, demise and lease, and to contract to let, demise and lease for the production of oil and gas and water, the following described property: 1st. 3/4 of SW 1/4 Sec. 33, Township 21, Range 13, containing 60 acres, more or less, and being owned and possessed by me in fee; and 2nd. 1/2 of NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 32, Township 21, Range 13, containing 20 acres, more or less, owned and possessed by Francis Ward, my daughter, a minor. It is understood that the power of attorney is to remain in full force and effect for a period of two years from this date, giving and granting unto my said attorney full power and authority to do and perform every act and thing whatsoever necessary and requisite to be done in the premises, as I might or could do if personally present. Hereby making said power and authority irrevocable until the purpose for which same is executed shall have been fully performed, according to the power herein granted.
