Territory of Sallie Brown of lawful age who being by me first duly sworn according to law upon her oath before and says:
"My name is Sallie Brown, my age is forty-one years and my first office is Sanktorore, Indian Territory. I am now the lawful
wife of Ben Brown and am living with him as his wife. My first husband's name is Sonny Smith and he and I were lawfully
married in August 1881 and lived with him as his wife for about ten years after our marriage when we separated and
both have since married and Sonny Smith is now living with his second wife whose name is Hattie. I had two children
by my first husband Sonny Smith the oldest one is named Flora Smith, a girl and the next one was named David
Smith, a boy. At the time my son David Smith was born there was present myself, Sonny Smith and Flora Murrell.
She said Flora Murrell attended me as the midwife at the time the said David Smith was born. My son David Smith
was born on the Ninth day of February 1886 and was twenty-one years old on the Ninth day of February 1902."
