Know All Men by These Presents: That the Homestead Realty Company, a corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the United States in force in the Indian Territory, in consideration of Three Hundred Dollars, cash in hand paid to it by J. J. Shrimp the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto J. J. Shrimp all the following described parcel of land situate in the Homestead Addition to the town of Broken Arrow, Creek Nation, Indian Territory (according to the survey of said addition, a subdivision of the southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of northwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$ , the west  $\frac{1}{2}$  of southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$ , and southeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 11 Township 18 north range 14 east) said parcel of land being known and designated upon the plat thereof as

Lot number 13, 14, 15, 16 & 17 Block number 12

To Have and to Hold The aforegranted premises unto the said J. J. Shrimp and his heirs in fee simple forever, and the said Homestead Realty Company, for itself, its successors and assigns, covenants with the said J. J.
