James A. Long,

Know All Men By These Presents:

That we Joseph J. Jones & Charlotte M. Jones wife of Joseph J. Jones, Creek Nation, Western District of the Indian Territory for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) By James A. Long the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do remise, release, sell, quit claim and convey unto the said James A. Long him and assigns, all the right, title, claim and demand, they have in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land, lying and being situate in the Western District of Indian Territory, Creek Nation, Indian Territory, to-wit: N 1/4 of N 1/4 of Section (10) in Township (19) North, in Range (13) East, Creek Nation, Indian Territory.

So Have and to Hold the same, with all thoughts, immunities, privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said James A. Long him and assigns, forever, so that neither the said Jones, nor his heirs nor any other person or persons for him or in his name or behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the aforesaid premises or any part thereof, but they and everyone of them shall, by these presents, be excluded and forever barred.

and I, Charlotte M. Jones wife of the said Joseph J. Jones in consideration of the sum of money so paid, do hereby relinquish to the said James A. Long all my of dower and Homestead in to said land.
