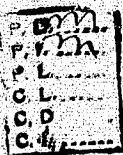

Know All Men by These Presents: That the Homestead Realty Company, a corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the United States in force in the Indian Territory, in consideration of Two hundred twenty-five (\$225) dollars, cash in hand, paid to it by Pauline D. Cooper the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Pauline D. Cooper all the following described parcel of land situate in the Homestead Addition to the town of Broken Arrow, Creek Nation, Indian Territory, (according to the survey of said addition, a sub-division of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of southwest $\frac{1}{4}$, the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of southwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 11 Township 18 north range 14 east) said parcel of land being known and designated upon the plat thereof as:

Lots number 19, 20, 21 and 23 Block number 14.

To Have and to Hold the aforegranted premises unto the said Pauline D. Cooper and her heirs in fee simple forever, and the said Homestead Realty Company, for itself, its successors and assigns, covenants with the said Pauline D. Cooper and her heirs and assigns that it is lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises, and that the same are free from all encumbrances; that it has a good right to sell and convey the same to the said Pauline D. Cooper as aforesaid; and that it will, and its successors shall warrant and defend the same to the said Pauline D. Cooper and her heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
