"My name is Flora Murrell my age is twenty years and my post office is Elliott, Indian Territory. I am the mother of Henry Smith and the grand mother of David Smith. I have known David Smith all of his life and was present at the time of his birth and attended his mother see him when he was very present at the time of the birth of David Smith the morning three years to wit: myself; Henry Smith and Lellie Smith who have is now Lellie Brown, she said Lellie Brown was at that time the wife of my son Henry Smith and was known then as Lellie Smith and she and my son Henry Smith departed and she afterwards married a man by the name of Brown and her name is now Lellie Brown.
