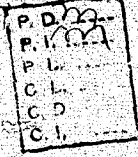

Witnesseth, that the party of the first part for and in consideration of the rents and covenants hereinafter mentioned on the part of the party of the second part has this day leased unto the said party of the second part the following described premises for a period of five years from the first day of January A.D. 1902, to-wit: the North Half of the South East Fourth of Section (28) Township (18) Range (14) East, Creek Native Indian Territory.

Said party of the second part in consideration of said lease as provided on the part of the party of the first part is to pay said party of the first part for said premises during said period of time the sum of \$500.00 cash in hand the receipt whereof is this day acknowledged at the execution of this lease,
