Warranty deed

Now the all men by these presents, that Johannes Regier, a citizen of the Creek Nation, and residents of Keokuk, Oklahoma, ⁱⁿ consideration of the sum of \$11.00 and other good and valuable considerations to me paid by the Mansfield and Company, a corporation of Muskogee Indian Territory, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said Mansfield and Company, its successors and assigns forever, the following described lot or parcels of land, lying and being situate in the Creek Nation in Indian Territory, to-wit:

The Northwest Quarter, Johnston City, (190), Iowa
England (18) North and Range - Elmore (11) East

English (18) North and Range Eleven (11) East.

Englewood 11/18 North and Range - section 102
do agree and defend the title to said lands against all lawful claims & claims
in whatsoever and assigns in fee simple forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging, and
I, Johnnie Rogers, my heirs and assigns, hereby consent with the said Mansfield Land Company,
that said lands are free from all encumbrances, and that I, my heirs and assigns will forever
warrant and defend the title to said lands against all lawful claims & claims in whatever

current and defend the rule in our country
And — says the said James Rogers, for the consideration aforementioned, so heavily
release unto the said Monmouth Lord Comptrolr all my rights of dower and homestead
mould & hard lands

in and to hard length
