Know all men by these presents
That I, N.J. Huber Recorder of the Incorporated City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, for and on behalf of said city for and in consideration of the sum of Ten and ^{no}/₁₀₀ dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said G.C. Morrison and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the City Cemetery of the Incorporated City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, in the S. one half of the S.E. Quarter of S.E. Quarter, of Section 1, Township 19, North, Range 13 East, to wit:
all of Block 270.

To Have and to Hold the same unto the said grantee G.C. Morrison and unto his heirs & assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said grantee G.C. Morrison that the Incorporated City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all claims whatever.

In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand as Recorder of the Incorporated City of Tulsa Indian Territory, for and on behalf of said city, and have hereunto affixed the Official Seal of said City on this 22 day of November A.D., 1905.
