Lots No. five (5) and six (6) Block No. Twenty Eight (28) according to the survey and plat filed thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said grantee and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances therunto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said grantee that it will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.
