Deed of Release

Know All Men by These Presents: That The First National Bank of Tulsa, I.T. for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$100) dollars to it Paid by O. B. Lynch and E. J. Lynch do hereby grant, sell, quit claim and Release unto the said O. B. Lynch and E. J. Lynch and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the Creek Nation Western District Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lot Four (4) in Block One Hundred and Forty Six (146) and all of Lot Eight (8) in Block One Hundred and Seventeen (117) in the Town of Tulsa Western District Indian Territory.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated March 5th, 1904 and filed in the Office the United States Clerk and Recorder at Sapulpa, I.T. April 9th, 1904 at 9 A.M. and Recorded in Book F Page 130. by O. B. Lynch and E. J. Lynch, his wife conveying said property to Grantor herein to secure the payment of one certain note therein named the same having been fully paid.
