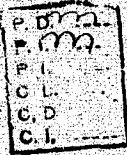

Quit Claim Deed

This Indenture, made this 28th day of May 1907 between J. M. Orr and Eliza L. Orr his wife, parties of the first part, of Vinita Indian Territory, Northern District, and Lina B. Damough party of the second part, of Vinita, D. T.

Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of nine hundred sixty six and 47/100 Dollars to us in hand paid by the said party of the second part, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have remised, released, sold, conveyed, quitclaimed, and by these presents do remise, release, sell and convey and grant unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, the right to perpetual occupancy thereof, and do also grant and assign all the right, title, interest, claim and possession which the said parties of the first part have in and to the following described lot piece or parcel of land, situated in Northern District Indian Territory, and described as follows, to-wit: An undivided 1/2 interest in and to the SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section (20) Township (20) ^{North} Range (13) E, being the surplus allotment land of John P. Chandler.

To Have and to Hold the same together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right title, interest and claim of the said parties of the first part, either in law or equity forever.
