Release of Mortgaged Premises

said mortgage having been filed for record on the 16 day of June A.D. 1904 and recorded in Book 7, at page M, in the office of the Deputy Clerk of the United States Court and its Office Recorder at Wagoner, Indian Territory, and which was given to secure the payment of a note for \$700.00 and, whereas said indebtedness has been paid and satisfied in full:

Now, in the consideration of the payment of said indebtedness ~~in full~~ ^{and by these presents} and other consideration to me in hand paid by said Addie Pennington and William Pennington the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I have granted, released, quit claim and set over unto the said Addie Pennington and William Pennington their heirs and assigns, all my right, title and interest in and to said mortgaged property, together with all the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the intent that the property hereby conveyed may be discharged from said mortgage. To have and to hold the lands and premises hereby released and conveyed unto the said Addie Pennington and William Pennington their heirs and assigns, and to their proper use, benefit and behoof; forever free, clear, and discharged of and from all lien and claim under and by virtue of the mortgage aforesaid.
