Ter. party of the second part, Witness that the party of the first part hereby agrees to sell to the party of the second part any time within twelve months from this date the following lands to wit the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 and the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section two (2) Town twenty one (21) Range twelve (12) in the Cherokee Nation, for the sum of Five hundred and fifty Dollars \$550.00 and upon the payment of the sum of \$550.00 to him in cash the party of the first part agrees to make the party of the second part a deed to the above described land.
