Now on this day this cause came on to be heard upon the application of Emma Drew, one of the above named plaintiffs to have the Court to order the clerk to enter a decree nunc pro tunc as that of March 30th 1905, correcting a clerical error in the final decree heretofore entered in this cause of that date describing the land set aside to and apportioned to George B. Perryman, Jr.
And it appearing to the court from the records of this case that the commissioner is partitioning said estate, partitioned to said George B. Perryman, Jr., the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4, and the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and lot 3, in the W 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 12, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, containing 22.86 =
and it further appearing to the court that in the entry of said final decree a clerical error in the description of the land set aside and partitioned to the said George B. Perryman Jr. was made, making said description in said decree to read as follows:
the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and lot 3, of the W 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 12, Township 19 North Range 12 East.
It is therefore, adjudged and decreed that the clerk of this court correcting the said entry of the said final decree according to the facts, and that he make the description of the land partitioned to the said George B. Perryman, Jr., read as follows:
