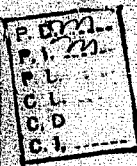

Deed of Release

To Melville B. Baird

Know all men by these presents, that the Union Trust Company (an Indian Territory Corporation) of Tulsa Ind. Ter. for and in consideration of the sum of six thousand 000 Dollars, to it paid by Melville B. Baird does hereby grant, sell, quitclaim and release unto the said Melville B. Baird & Katherine Baird and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory to-wit:

Situate in the Town of Tulsa, Indian Territory, and being the whole of lot nine (9) in Block Fifty nine (59), and all of lot six (6) in Block Forty (40); and the South Eighty-five (85 ft) of lot One (1) in said Block Forty (40), being all of said lot except a strip fifty (50) feet wide off and along north side of same; and all of lot seven (7) in said Block Forty (40) except Fifty (50) feet square in the North-east corner of same. This is intended hereby to include and convey all the interests of the grantors in said lots and Blocks in said town of Tulsa, privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all buildings and structures thereon.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain mortgage dated June 8th, 1906 and recorded June 9th, 1906 at 9:15 a.m. in Book 14 at Page 442 of the records of Mortgages at Sapulpa Ind. Ter.

This deed of release is made by the undersigned officer of the Union Trust Company in pursuance of the authority conferred upon him in article VII of the by-laws of said company as follows:

The Secretary shall have equal power with the President to satisfy and release mortgages, judgments or certificates of trust; to execute contracts release or other instruments in the transaction of the company's business.
