Know ye all men by these presents: That whereas, J. James Lane,
a Creek citizen, executed and paid deed No. 1304, having received as my
homestead allotment, the following described tract of land being in
the Creek nation, to-wit:

The Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 26, T. 10N.,
R. 10E., M. 10N. (19 North and Range 10 East) (14) Acres.

Therefore, J. James Lane, for and in behalf of myself, for a consideration
of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations,

have leased, let and delivered, and by these presents do let, lease
and deliver unto J. Hartfield Hall of Muskogee Indian Territory,

all of the above described premises for the term of five years, for
agricultural purposes, from the 27th day of July, 1907;

And I covenant with the said J. Hartfield Hall, that I may have
and assign will protect the said J. Hartfield Hall, his heirs and

assigns, in a quiet and peaceful possession of the above described
land for the full term of five years.

In witness whereof, I the said James Lane, have hereunto set
my hand and seal this 27th day of July, 1907.
