Whereas E. Reynolds of Elder D.T. by deed of Trust dated July 28 1907 and recorded in the Clerk's office of the United States Court for the Western District of the Indian Territory at Tulsa, Indian Territory in Book 12, page 345, conveyed to The City National Bank of Muskogee D.T. the property in said deed described to secure the payment of the note and the interest thereon, in said deed fully described and set forth; and, whereas, the said E. Reynolds has paid and satisfied said note and the interest and is justly entitled to a release of said deed of Trust.

Now, Therefore, the City National Bank does hereby remise, release and quitclaim unto the said E. Reynolds and his heirs, successors and assigns, the property in said deed of Trust described as follows to-wit: The North one half (1/2) and the S.W. quarter (1/4) of the S.W. quarter (1/4) of Section Twenty seven (27) Township seventeen (17) North Range fourteen (14) East, except the right of way of the Midland Valley Ry. Co.

To Have and To Hold the same, with all the appurtenances thereto belonging, free, clear and discharged from the encumbrances of said deed.
