This Agreement made and entered into this 28th day of September, 1906, by and between the Tulsa Commercial Bridge Company of Tulsa, Indian Territory, party of the first part, and the Galbreath Gas Company of Tulsa, Indian Territory, party of the second part, Witnesseth:

Party of the first part leases party of the second part the Toll Bridge, known as the Tulsa Commercial Bridge Company's bridge, that crosses the Arkansas River near the Trieco Railroad bridge, for the purpose of permitting said party of the second part to lay and maintain gas pipe line for conveyance of natural gas across said bridge for the term of twenty-one years. Said line to be placed where Yellow Guard now lies, also pipe to be buried a sufficient depth on approaches and bridge Company's right of way so as not to interfere with wagon traffic or grading roads.

It is agreed and understood by and between the parties hereto that the Galbreath Gas Company shall pay said Tulsa Commercial Bridge Company the sum of seventy-five (\$75.00) dollars for the first year; receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars per annum thereafter. Payment to be made the first day of October each year.

It is further agreed that the Galbreath Gas Company is to furnish gas for the parties occupying said Bridge Company's premises, known as "Bridge Office," free of charge during the period of this contract.

Said Galbreath Gas Company is to keep said portion of the line that enters upon and occupies that portion of the bridge that is required to lay and maintain said line on said bridge.

Said Bridge Company grants the right of way over any highway connected with said bridge owned and controlled by said company for the purpose of laying and maintaining said Galbreath Gas Company's pipe line.
