Know all men by these presents

That whereas on the 31st day of August
 1904, Austin Mc Lane as guardian of Clyde
 Mc Lane made and executed an oil and
 gas mining lease with James Mc Cormick
 upon the following described property
 to wit:

The west half $\frac{1}{2}$ of the south west
 quarter SW^{1/4} of section twenty one (21) township
 twenty one (21) north range thirteen (13) east
 in the Cherokee Nation Indian Territory,
 containing eighty (80) acres more or less,
 which said lease was duly approved by
 the Department of the Interior.

Now Therefore, in consideration of the
 sum of Three Hundred Dollars \$300⁰⁰ cash in
 hand paid the said James Mc Cormick hereby
 transfers, sells, assigns and sets over unto
 the Iron Mountain Oil Company of Lima
 Ohio, all his right title and interest in and
 to said oil and gas mining lease upon the
 land described above.

This assignment to be in full
 force and effect only when approved by
 the Secretary of the Interior
