That Ida Addie and Roosevelt Draper were freedman citizens of the Creek nation; and that the defendant John Draper is a non-citizen of the Creek nation; that Ida Draper died November 26th 1901; and left surviving her mother Addie Draper, and her brother Roosevelt Draper freedman citizens of the Creek nation, and her father John Draper a non citizen of the Creek nation; that Addie Draper died December 12th 1901 and left surviving her son Roosevelt Draper a freedman citizen of the Creek nation and her husband John Draper, a non citizen of the Creek nation; that Roosevelt Draper died August 10th 1902, and left surviving his father John Draper a non citizen of the Creek nation, his maternal grandfather Joseph Harrison his maternal grandmother Rachel Harrison; his maternal uncles R. Edward Harrison and David Harrison his maternal aunts Annie Harrison Douglass, Sarah Garrett Lela Lucky, Lila Howard Mary Bruner and Josie Lincoln his first cousin.

and that the defendants John Draper Joseph and Rachel Harrison Edward and David Harrison Annie Harrison Douglass Sarah Garrett Lela Lucky Lila Howard Mary Bruner sold under written contracts and conveyed by warranty deeds to the plaintiff the following described lands
