

Field, George F.

Mortgage

This Indenture Made this 9th day of December 1907
 between George F. Field (a single man) of the
 County of Rogers and State of Oklahoma, of the first part
 and Holmes Brothers a firm composed of Edward C. Holmes
 and Willard R. Holmes, of Kansas City, Missouri, of the second
 part.

Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, in consideration
 of the sum of Fifty and ^{no}/₁₀₀ dollars, the receipt of which is
 hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant bargain sell
 and convey unto said party of second part, or their assigns,
 all the following described real estate, situated in the County
 of Rogers and State of Oklahoma, to wit:

Northwest quarter of southwest quarter and northeast
 quarter of southwest quarter of the south west quarter ~~of the~~
~~south west quarter~~, all in section twenty three (23)

Township twenty-two (22) Range Thirteen, 13.

To have and to hold the same together with all and singular
 the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereto
 belonging or in any wise appertaining, forever. Provided, always
 and these presents are upon this express condition that said
 said George F. Field is indebted to said Holmes Brothers of
 Kansas City, Missouri, in the sum of Fifty and ^{no}/₁₀₀ dollars
 payable in installments, for which he has this day
 executed and delivered and by his agents and to said party
 of the second part bearing even date herewith, certain in law
 semi-annually installments of \$5.00 each on the first day
 of May and the first day of November in each year from
 May first 1908 to Nov. first 1912 and payable at the office of
 Holmes Brothers in Kansas City, Missouri, with or without
 or New York. And if default be made in the payment
 of any one of said installments within six months
