Oklahoma First Mortgage
Know All Men By These Presents
That William H. Pound and
Mary E. Pound, his wife, of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma,
parties of the first part, have mortgaged and hereby mortgage
to William B. Scott, party of the second part, the follow-
ing described real estate and premises, situated in
City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to wit:

Commencing at a point in the Northeast corner of
lot six in Block Thirteen North Tulsa, City of Tulsa, run-
ning thence along the lot line dividing lots 5 & 6 in
said block a distance of one hundred feet, thence in
a Southwesterly direction and parallel to the Northerly lot
line of said lot 6, a distance of fifty feet, thence in a
Northerly direction parallel to the said line divid-
ing said lots 5 & 6, to a point on the Northerly lot line
of said lot 6, a distance of one hundred feet, thence along
said Northerly lot line to the place of beginning, a distance
of fifty feet; the same being a parcel of land, 50x100 feet,
lying and being within said lot 6 in said block 13,
having a frontage of fifty feet on what was known as
North Sixth Street, with all the improvements thereon
