Oklahoma First Mortgage
Known All Men By These Presents
That William H. Pound and

Mary E. Pound, his wife, of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma parties of the first part, have mortgaged and hereby mortgage to William B. Scott, party of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situated in City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma to wit:

Commencing at a point in the Northeast corner of lot six in block Thirteen North Tulsa City of Tulsa, running thence along the lot line dividing lots 5 & 6 in said block, a distance of one hundred feet; thence in a Southwesterly direction and parallel to the Northerly lot line of said lot 6, a distance of fifty feet; thence in a Northwesterly direction parallel to the said line dividing said lots 5 & 6, to a point on the Northerly lot line of said lot 6, a distance of one hundred feet; thence along said Northerly lot line to the place of beginning, a distance of fifty feet; the same being a parcel of land, 50 x 100 feet, lying and being within said lot 6 in said block 13, having a frontage of fifty feet on what was known as North Sixth Street, with all the improvements thereon and appurtenances thereto belonging and warrant the title to the same.

This mortgage is given to secure the principal sum of Five hundred seventy one and $\frac{2}{100}$ Dollars due and payable on the 27th day of December 1912, with interest thereon at the rate of 7 per cent per annum, payable semi-annually from date, according to the terms and at the time and in the manner provided by one certain promissory note, given and signed by the maker hereof (William H. Pound and Mary E. Pound) and payable to the order of the mortgagee herein and being for the principal sum of Five
