

said above described premises, and that the same are clear, free and discharged from any and all liens, charges, taxes, assessments, incumbrances, claims and demands, and that she will and her heirs, executors and administrators shall forever warrant and defend the title herein conveyed to the parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, against the lawful claimants and demands of any and all persons whatsoever.

The above and foregoing conveyance is made, nevertheless, upon the express condition, that if the party of the first part shall fail and truly pay his said several promissory notes, at the time and in due course of payment, and secondly, shall keep the buildings on said premises insured in some good insurance company, for the benefit of the parties of the second part in the sum of \$— dollars, and thirdly, shall keep said above described buildings free, from all taxes and other charges, and fourthly, shall keep his personal property in said buildings free, from all liens and incumbrances in the sum of \$— dollars for the benefit of the parties of the second part, then the obligation to the ninth and tenth, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

And, moreover, the party of the first part shall fail to pay either or part thereof at the time the same falls due, or any part thereof, then each of said notes, and the several accounts of the above described indebtedness shall become due and payable at the time of the payment of the principal of the second part.
