

Oklahoma City Mortgage.

Know all men by these presents, That on the 15th day of January 1908 - Charles Ostdander and Carrie Ostdander, husband and wife of Tulsa County, and State of Oklahoma, parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars to them in hand paid, by The Service Investment Company, of Denver, Kansas, party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, give, mortgage and hereby mortgage unto the said The Service Investment Company, their executors and assigns, the following premises, situated in the county of Tulsa in the State of Oklahoma, with all the improvements thereon and appurtenances thereto belonging, together with rents, issues and profits thereof and more particularly bounded and described as follows, to wit: a tract of land five (5) acre hundred and fifty-nine (169) in the original town of Tulsa, more particularly described as follows:
