Provided always, and those provisions are upon
the express condition that, whenever the said
party of the second part, at the special instance
and request of said party of the first part,
loaned and advanced to Henry Kincaid and his
wife Marice Kincaid the sum of eight
hundred and ^{no}/₁₀₀ dollars.

1868 this day pledged by me to said association

and the sum of five $\frac{1}{2}$ dollars, the same being
the interest due monthly upon said loan, so
forwaded by me and the sum of one $\frac{1}{2}$ dollar
the same being the promise due monthly
upon said loan, so forwaded, and expense
