Tulsa Indian Territory, hereafter known as parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar \$1.00 to us in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the covenants stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained, do hereby grant, bargain, sell convey and deliver to W. L. North Trustee for the uses and purposes hereinafter specified the following described lots and tracts of lands in the Western District of the Indian Territory to wit: -

Block fourteen (14) of the College Addition to the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory bounded on the north by Fifth Street on the east by Sixth Street on the south by Seventh Street and on the west by College Street.

To have and to hold unto the said W. L. North Trustee and to his successors for the uses and purposes hereinafter mentioned.
