

Real Estate Mortgage.

The Vendition, made on the 20th day of March, A.D., 1907, and between B. H. Hatchet, Jr. of the last, Oklahoma, party of the first part, and Elias Page, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the second part, it is recited that, whereas, the said B. H.
