Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, doo and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and no^o too dollars, to them in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part, and to his Heire^{and} assigns forever, all^o of the following described tract, piece or parcel of land lying and situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to wit:

The Northwest Quarter of the Southeast quarter (3/8 1/4) S 8 1/4, Section Two (2), Township Sixteen (16) North, and of Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base Meridian.

(To have and to hold the same, with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and all rights of Homestead exemption unto the said party of the second part, and to its Heire^{and} assigns forever,

And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of said party of the
