"It was received - we promise to pay to the order of the Home and Home Savings and Loan Association of Wisconsin, the following sum of money, viz: The sum of fifteen \$100 dollars, the same being the monthly dues on the 1% share of the Capital Stock of said Association, represented and evidenced by the certificate thereof, numbered #1599 this day pledged by us to said Association to secure a loan of fourteen hundred dollars, and the sum of nine \$100 dollars, the same being the interest due monthly upon said sum so loaned by us and the sum of two & 1/2 dollars, the same being the premium due monthly upon said sum so loaned; and we promise to pay said Association as its share of the Office of the said Association, all of the said sum of money, amounting in the aggregate to twenty-eight dollars, on the 20th day of each and every month, and continue such monthly payments until the due payments on stock together with the earnings and profits credited thereon shall make said certificate of stock equal to the par value of said certificate of stock, and said certificate of stock in estimated to mature and reach par value in twenty-two months from date thereof. And we further agree, in case of default in the payment of said sum of money, or any part thereof, monthly or otherwise to pay all price and penalties secured on account thereof, in accordance with the rules and regulations of said Association, and if in case of default, the stock pledged and the security given to secure said monthly payments shall, in the said case, be sufficient to pay said Association any balance which may be due and owing or said loan we promise and agree to supply and discharge the same. The payment of said monthly dues aggregate twenty-eight dollars each and
