 formity to the provisions of the Act of Congress
 approved April 23, 1904 33 Stats 204 I have made
 a full investigation in connection with the
 application of John Deems a citizen by
 blood of the Cherokee Nation for the removal of
 the restrictions upon the alienation of his allot-
 ment (except his homestead) and am as the result
 of that investigation, satisfied that satisfied
 that the removal of restrictions upon the
 alienation of his allotted lands except as to his
 homestead will be for the best interests of the
 allottee and I so recommend. The approval of
 this Certificate does not in any manner
 determine the right of the allottee to any partic-
 ular tract of land.
