Stipulation of Settlement and for Dis-
missal of Appeal Taken by Both Parties in This
Cause, Same Being # 907 on the Docket of the
Supreme Court of the State of Oklahoma.

Whereas parties to this controversy
desiring a settlement of the same without
further cost and expense, have agreed up-
on the terms of the settlement, each con-
ceding to the other a part of its respective
contentions:
