Order Confirming Sale Lease and
Conveyance of Interest in

Now, to wit: on this 24th day of January, 1908, came being one of the regular judicial days of the regular January, 1908, term of the above entitled Court, the matter of the confirmation of the sale, conveyance and leasing to Charles Page of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section Nineteen Township Nineteen North, of Range Twelve East, of the Indian Meridian, and of the North Half and the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section Nineteen in Township Nineteen North of Range Twelve East, of the Indian Meridian, all in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, for oil and gas purposes, come on for hearing upon the report of Willie Fisher, guardian of said minor Ellis Fisher, heretofore made and filed in this court on the 9th day of January, 1908, and thereupon it appearing to the Court that said sale to Charles Page was legally made and fairly conducted, and that the sum bid was not disproportionate to the value of the property sold, and that a greater sum cannot be obtained, and that said property has been appraised within one year of the time of such sale and that the appraisement thereof is just and that the sum bid is at least ninety (90) per cent of the appraised value thereof, and the Court having examined the return and the witnesses in relation to the same, and it appearing to the Court that this is the time fixed for the hearing of this report of sale and for the confirmation thereof and that ten (10) days notice has been given by the Judge of this Court by notices posted in three (3) public places in the County indicating the land sold and the sum for which sold and referring to the return of sale for further particulars.
