And further upon the payment of one thousand dollars at any time by the party of the second part, his or her assigns to the party of the first part his heirs and assigns said lease shall have the right to surrender this lease for cancellation, after which all payments and liabilities hereafter to accrue under and by virtue of this lease shall cease and terminate and the lease become absolutely null and void. All the conditions between the parties hereto shall stand and apply to them here and hereafter, administrators and assigns.
