

Guardian Deed of Real Estate Executed
By Direction Of The County Court.

This Indenture made and entered into the 11th day
of January in the year of our Lord one thousand
nine hundred and eight at Tulsa, State of Oklahoma,
by and between John Dicloud, the duly appointed, qualified
and acting guardian of Bertha Diblow and
Charles Diblow, minor, the party of the first part,
and James H. Mc Birney of said Tulsa, the party of the
second part, witnessed:- That whereas, on the
Twenty-ninth day of November, A.D. 1907, the County
Court of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma made
an order of sale authorizing the said party of the
