

contract; and if said land does not produce an amount of gas more than sufficient to enable the party of the first part to comply with the terms and conditions of this contract then in that event, the party of the second part its subsidiary and affiliated companies shall have the entire output of gas produced or to be produced in or from said above described lands the same to be paid for as hereinbefore provided.

(G) It is further understood and agreed on by and between the parties hereto that the party of the first part shall have the right to sell gas produced on said above described lands to such other persons who may be desirous of purchasing the same so long as the sale of said gas does not interfere with the party of the second part its subsidiary and affiliated companies procuring an amount of gas sufficient for their own use and purpose up to One Million (1,000,000) cubic feet per day and shall have the right at its own cost and expense to tap the pipe line, put down by the party of the second part and to make connections therewith at any point thereon but said right to sell and dispose of said gas depends wholly upon the fact that said party of the first part shall have in reserve three (3) times the
