

Assignment.

For and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars to me in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the receipt in full of all sums, (debts, demands or claims) of whatever nature up to and including 12 o'clock noon of the 22nd day of January, 1908, paid and granted to me, W.W. MacCall, now of Tulsa Oklahoma, by Archibald Campbell of Detroit, Michigan, I, the said W.W. MacCall do hereby sell, transfer, set over and assign unto the said Archibald Campbell all my right, title and interest in and to certain oil lease made to me, W.W. MacCall by one George W. Ware, of Collinsville, Oklahoma, bearing date of January 22nd, 1908, and conveying all that tract and parcel of land known and described as follows:

The Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW 1/4 SE 1/4) of Section Thirty-four (34), Township Twenty-two (22) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Meridian, and containing forty acres more or less.

This assignment is intended to and does transfer, assign and set over and deliver all rights conveyed to me by the said George W. Ware which are all the rights, privileges and requirements conveyed in said lease, there existing no other interest in the said lease except those conveyed herein to the said Archibald Campbell by me the said W.W. MacCall.
