Mohawk Mining Company.
This contract and agreement
made and entered into this 14th
day of Nov. 1907, by and between Waddie McCoy and Carrie Mc-
Coy, daughter of the first party, and the Mohawk Mining Com-
pany, party of the second part.

Witnesseth; The parties of the first part grant
bargain and sell to the parties of the second part all
coal underlying the following described land west of
the present pit now on said land, to wit:

The south half of the north half of the southwest
quarter of the northwest quarter, and the south half
of the southwest quarter, and a strip one hundred and
fifty feet off the west side of the southeast quarter
of the northwest quarter of section twenty two, town-
ship twenty one, range thirteen east, in the Cherokee
Nation Indian Territory. The said south half of the
north half of the southwest quarter of the northwest quar-
ter and the strip one hundred and fifty feet wide of
the west side of the southeast quarter, the northwest
quarter belonging to the above Waddie McCoy, and the
south half of the southwest quarter of the northwest
quarter belonging to the said Carrie McCoy.

Parties of the second part agree to pay all expenses
of stripping and taking out said coal without any
expense whatever to the parties of the first part or
either of them and agree to pay to the above named
Waddie McCoy twenty cents (\$.20) per ton for all coal
taken from that portion of said land described as
belonging to him, and agree to pay to the said Carrie McCoy
twenty five cents (\$.25) per ton for all coal taken from
that portion of said land described as belonging
to her.
