

Oil and Gas Lease

The agreement made and entered into this 20 day of January, A.D. 1908, by and between viz. the guardian of Eagle Hill, a minor of Esmeralda, California, holder of the first gas lease and H. L. Brock Oil Company, of Tulsa Ok. a corporation organized and doing business under and by virtue of the laws of the United States, in and in the said Territory and State of Oklahoma, party of the second, do hereby

testify that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereunto inserted and the sum of \$100.00 in cash in hand paid hereby acknowledged, has granted, granted and let unto the party of the second part, its successors and assigns, for the purpose and exercise of drilling and operating for and producing oil and gas, all on the following described property, to-wit: South-east quarter of section thirty, township sixteen Range, south-east of T. 22 N. Range, Oklahoma, situated at a town within the said party of the second part may deem advisable, together with the right to lay, erect and maintain all necessary pipe and pipe lines, tanks, structures, rods, cable and all other fixtures and machinery used in drilling for, pumping, securing, storing and transporting the product or said premises. The party of the second part shall further have the right of using sufficient water from the public supply - surface, and if necessary the right to
