A. B. Norton } This assignment made this 14th
day of November 1907 in and
between James Bowen party of the first part
and A. B. Norton party of the second part Witness-
eth: That for and in consideration of the sum
of \$25.00 the receipt of which is hereby acknow-
ledged the party of the first part does hereby
assign unto the party of the second part
his line and assigns a one fourth $\frac{1}{4}$
interest in and to a certain Oil and Gas
Lease from Walter Dickeler to the said
party of the first part dated the 12 day
of November 1907 and recorded November 2nd
1907 in Book 20 at page 420 of the records
of the United States Court and ex-officio Re-
corder at Tulsa Indian Territory.

Said Lease covering the East half of the
north-east quarter of Section nine (9) Township
twenty one (21), Range thirteen (13) east line
the allotment of Stella Linzy Finis deceased.

This assignment is made and accepted
subject to all the conditions of the lease above
described.
