

State of Oklahoma. { In the County Court. Order of Confirmation.
County of Tulsa. On the matter of the estate of Wilbur
Emory Campbell deceased. No. 157.

It appearing to the Court at a hearing on this 12th day
of February, 1908, that on the 28th day of January, 1908, Emily
M. Campbell executrix in the above entitled cause, filed
her petition in this Court praying for the confirmation
of the sale of the land herein described; and

It further appearing to the Court that on the said
28th day of January, 1908, the Court made an order setting
the 12th day of February, 1908, for the hearing of said petition,
and in said order required the publication of notice of
said hearing for a period of ten days previous to the
said 12th day of February, 1908; and

It further appearing to the Court that under the terms
of the will of the above named decedent, the said will
having been admitted to probate in this Court on the
10th day of December, 1907, the executrix, Emily M. Camp-
bell, the Petitioner aforesaid, was authorized and em-
powered to sell and dispose of any and all of the real estate
of said decedent as to her seemed fit and proper; and

It further appearing to the Court that in accordance
with said power and authority given in said will the ^{said} ex-
ecutrix, Emily M. Campbell, sold to J. Fred Wood Lot 1 in
Block 2 of the O. P. O. Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,
for the sum of \$500.00 and

It further appearing to the Court that no special mode of
sale was required by said will of the said decedent, and
that said sale was legally made and fairly conducted, that
the sum paid was more than 90% of the appraised value of
said lots, and that no greater sum than above specified
could be obtained; and

It further appearing to the Court that the said executrix
filed her return of said proceedings of said sale on the said 28th
day of January, 1908, as stated herein, and
