Witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the
 sum of One Hundred Dollars, (\$100.00) Cash in hand
 paid by the Party of the second part, the receipt of the
 same being hereby acknowledged, said first Party here-
 by rents, lets, and leases for the term of five years,
 for Agricultural purposes only, the following land
 lying in Tulsa County, and in the State of Oklahoma,
 and described more particularly as follows to-wit:

The south one half of the southeast Quarter of Sec-
 tion 13, Township 20 North, Range 13 East, being 80
 acres more or less as the case may be.

To have and to hold to the Party of the second part
 for the aforesaid term of five years, and said
 second Party hereby agrees to and with the Party of
 the first part, that it will keep up improvements on
 the above described land, and give peaceable possession
 of same at the expiration of this Contract.
