Witnesseth That, whereas the within named
Parties of the first part are the sole absolute owners
of all the tankage, tubing, casing and pumping plant
and all other supplies situated and now being upon
the following described land situated in the Creek
Nation To-wit:

West Quarter, and the East Half of the West Half of the
South West Quarter of the North West Quarter, and the
East Half of the West Half of the West Half of the South
West Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section Twenty
Three (23), Township Nineteen (19) North and Range Twelve
(12) East of the Indian Meridian and

Whereas the Parties of the first part together
with R. B. Blake of Belcher, North Carolina, are sole
and exclusive owners of an oil and gas mining lease
executed by Wiley Sooker on the 24th day of September,
1903, which lease was duly approved by the Honorable
Secretary of the Interior on March 19th 1904. Now there-
fore the Parties of the first part for and in consider-
ation of the sum of \$3250.00 the receipt of one half thereof,
or \$1625.00 being hereby acknowledged, the remaining
