

Release By Heirship.

To All Whom It May Concern. This is to certify that Sarah E. Jackson and Ella S. Butte sisters and sole heirs at law of Webster C. Baker of Rogers County, Oklahoma for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do release, relinquish and assign to the Oliver Oil Company, a corporation of Tulsa Oklahoma all their right, title and interest that they now have or may hereafter have in the allotment of Webster C. Baker situated in Tulsa County Oklahoma, and more fully describe as follows, to-wit:

The East half of the South West Quarter of Section Nine Township 21, Range 13 East, either in law or equity so far as it applies to oil and gas mining purposes on the above described land for a period of fifteen years beginning the 6th day of November 1907. In case of the death of the said Webster C. Baker any interest that would accrue to him if living shall be retained by us.
