C. at and before the delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby bargain, sell and deliver unto the said F. B. Henderson the following personal property, to wit: One lot in North Tucker. Said lot fronts 75 ft on Cherokee St and lies on the north side of the boundary line between the Cherokee and Creek Waters. Said lot extends back east from Cherokee St a distance of 100 ft. To have and to hold the said lot unto the said F. B. Henderson, his executors, administrators and assigns forever. And of the said C. A. Watkins do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the title to said bargain against F. B. Henderson unto the said F. B. Henderson, his executors, administrators and assigns, from and against the claims of all persons whomsoever.
